As part of the Application process, please schedule the following:

☐ Shadow day for your student(s) in First through Eighth Grade
☐ Shadow hours for your student(s) in Kindergarten, Pre-K 3 or Pre-K 4

Application Process
☐ Complete the online application per applicant for Pre-Kindergarten 3 through Eighth Grade
☐ If applying for Pre-Kindergarten 3, the Expectations Agreement Form must be reviewed and signed
☐ Submit fee payments via FACTS Financial (see 'Important Information' for fees)
☐ Baptismal Certificate (per applicant, if applicable)
☐ Birth Certificate (per applicant)
☐ Most recent Health Assessment Record
☐ Previous report cards for students entering First to Eighth Grade only
☐ MAPS/Current standardized test scores for students entering Third to Seventh Grade only

Important Information

- If applying for Pre-Kindergarten 3, a child must be three years old by September 1st
- If applying for Pre-Kindergarten 4, a child must be four years old by September 1st
- Fees per applicant as follows:
 - o \$150 non-refundable registration fee
 - \$300 non-refundable deposit (will be applied to tuition)
- Parish Confirmation Form is required for all current and incoming families to be eligible for the Parish Grant
- Once we receive your child's required information and payment, your enrollment will be complete, and we can welcome you to SBS!
- If the applicant had previously applied and was placed on our waitlist, please submit a new application for the current school year
- Once the application has been submitted with all the necessary documents, a screening will be scheduled for all applicants entering Pre-Kindergarten through Eighth Grade
